

Matthew 3:1-12




John the Baptist

Response #1

(v4-5) Large numbers <u>confessed</u> their sins and were <u>baptized</u>

(Lk 3:10-14) Asked for instruction

- <u>Generosity</u>
- Honesty
- Kindness
- <u>Contentment</u>

Response #2

(v7) Stealth resistance

- Dangerous and <u>hypocritical</u>
- Skeptical critical spirit (Jn 1:19ff)
- Unrepentant self-satisfied
- Concerned about control

Response #3 (Lk 3:19-20) Outright hostility



John's Message Focuses on the "good" people who feel little or no need of Jesus...


His message makes the uncomfortable comfortable and the comfortable uncomfortable.

Self Test
